Selection Process

- Expedition leader is Walter Zörer
- Expedition leader will make the final selection of the team with the assistance of the IFMGA (Peter Kimmig).
 - o Member associations will provide recommendations to Walter and Peter
- Selection of participants is described in Goals and Who Will Be the Team?, listed in this document below, but the general parameters for participants are:
 - o Team players
 - The main task is not to summit, but to make a good demonstration for the park and build good friendship with the park
 - o Plan for teams of 'one guide, two clients'
 - Make use of the time on the mountain
- Timeline:
 - Have team selected by November meeting in Edinburgh
- Details for the Process:
 - Participants should provide an alpine CV with a short written paragraph describing how they meet the goals and criteria of the expedition.
 - President or TD of member associations will send these documents (CV and letter) to Walter Zörer and Peter Kimmig.
 - o Deadline to receive the CV's: 15.10.2012

Goals:

- 1. It is an exchange of IFMGA guides instructors, this year it happens that we will hold it on Denali.
- 2. Instructor onward training ('continued professional development') and exchange on international basis referring to the IFMGA guidelines (Guided/Led/...Expeditions)
- 3. We seek to have an open discussion on communication, with a sharing of experience and knowledge in the actual environment.
- 4. Summit climb is included in the goal is but not the main goal

Who will be in the team?

The main goal is that each participant is a successful part of the team.

- 1. One guide from each member country
- 2. 10 places to fill plus Expedition Leader and AMGA Liaison = 12 people maximum
- 3. The criteria for participants is as follows:
 - Preferably instructors from guide training in each country (but not required)
 - High altitude guiding experience (one or two trips, over 6000 m)
 - Team player
 - English speaking
 - Good soft skills, good communicator
 - Not a professional climber
 - A guide respected in their guiding community (a 'good guide' balanced, good client care, able to read and respond to clients, good risk management)
 - Open-minded

Expectations for Each Expedition Member

- 1. Strive to achieve the goals of the expedition.
- 2. Treat all parties NPS, the IFMGA team, other guides, other with respect and courtesy.
- 3. Consider themselves a member of the team versus an individual striving for the summit.
- 4. Have the technical abilities to perform safely and reasonably participate in the expedition
- 5. Hold in high value the exchange between professionals. Have a willingness to participate in exchange between professionals.
- 6. Take pictures and videos for use by the expedition press
